Open Up Your Life.

Before setting up your smartphone, be sure to insert your fully charged battery. You can refer to your BlackBerry User Guide to help you get started.

Choosing your email setup option.

Now let's set up your wireless email, so you can start exchanging messages right away. Depending on your needs, you can use either the BlackBerry® Internet Service email option or the BlackBerry® Enterprise Server option (outlined below).

BlackBerry Internet Service email option:

Use this option to create a new email address for your smartphone or to connect your smartphone with one or more (up to 10) existing email addresses.

*Setting up your BlackBerry Internet Service email

1. If there's an Email Setup option on your smartphone's home screen, click it. **OR** in the setup wizard, **select I want to create or add an email address.**
2. **Click Next**, then if necessary, **click Update Now.**
3. If necessary, **click Create New Account.**
4. To accept the terms of the license agreement, **select Yes** and **click I Agree.**

To link an existing, supported email address with your smartphone, **click Add An Email Account** if necessary, or simply type in your existing email address and password. **Click Next.**

To create a new email address for your BlackBerry® smartphone (i.e., **username@csouth1@blackberry.com**), you'll need to:

Click Create a BlackBerry email address OR click I would like to create a new BlackBerry email address.

Type the user name you want to appear before the @ sign in your new BlackBerry email address.

If necessary, type a password for this email address and if prompted, select or **choose Secret question**. If necessary, provide an answer for the secret question you've selected. **Click Next.**

*These setup instructions apply only to the newest version of BlackBerry Internet Service.

BlackBerry Enterprise Server option: Use this option to associate your smartphone with a Microsoft® Outlook, IBM® Lotus® Notes® or Novell® GroupWise® work email account and wireless data synchronization capabilities. If your system administrator has provided you with an enterprise activation password, you can set up email using this option by selecting **I want to use a work email account with a BlackBerry Enterprise Server** in the setup wizard on your smartphone. If you don't have an enterprise activation password, contact your system administrator.
